Regarding the criteria, you can only say that in this task they do not play such a huge role as in the case of essay, for example. This is due to the fact that in these tasks almost the entire volume of your historical knowledge is involved. It is understood that in a specific context, you can choose such a fact or an argument, which may not be in the criteria, but it will not be correct to be correct and most importantly - you will not lose the score.

In fact, this section of the exam can be divided into two parts:

Tasks 20-22: Work with historical text / document.

Jobs 23-24: Universal (I will explain below why I called them so).

Now about each of them in more detail.

Working with a historical document

Tasks 20-22 In general, not so complex, but their successful writing primarily depends on your care and knowledge.

The basic rule for 20 and 21 tasks is an attentive reading of the task and the text presented. This can be anything in any temporary gap: from the disbuild from the birch diplomas of the X century to the rulings of the middle / end of the XX century. Therefore, you should be ready to be all. In these tasks, you will be asked to work with the text and write out the necessary information from there. The best advice here will be checked keywords: names, years, countries, contracts, terms.

Otherwise, you can get bogged down in a huge amount of information and do not understand the task, because the text presented / document is always quite voluminous, and the keywords will help to highlight the highlights and give you the opportunity to navigate quickly in it. 22 The task is also associated with the text, but it is sent to him only partly. It will be asked a question solely on the subject of text. However, the answer to it in the text you will not find - here you will need knowing the period. Important moment! In 50% percent of cases in the 20th task, they can also request key information on events and individuals from the text (years of government, position, names, organizations and TP), which will not be in it.

Universal tasks

Tasks 23-24 without jokes are the most difficult in history, and many people spend on their writing even more time and strength than on the essay and 1 part combined. But still, are these tasks so scary?
